



Lax Scholarship Requirements Checklist

Please use the checklist below to determine whether your application is complete. We must receive all the information listed below to consider your scholarship application. Questions should be directed to lax@breadrosesfund.org or 215-731-1107, x204.

Applications will not be considered unless all of these materials are received by 5:00 p.m. on the first Monday in February.

Eligibility Requirements

- Applicants must be openly gay males.
- Applicants must be from the five-county metropolitan Philadelphia region (Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery, and Philadelphia) or Camden County, NJ, and attending an accredited degree granting college, graduate, or professional school in or out of the region

OR

Applicants from outside the area must be attending an accredited degree granting college, graduate, or professional school within the five-county metropolitan Philadelphia region (Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery, and Philadelphia), or Camden County, NJ.

Application Requirements

 - Education Experience
 - An essay of 1000 words or less on your activist work in the community as an openly gay man
- Official School Transcripts** (You must submit transcripts from all schools attended)
 - High School
 - College (if applicable)
 - Graduate School (if applicable)
- Three Letters of Recommendation** (Letters of reference should be signed and sealed by the person writing the reference.)
 - Personal
 - Academic
 - Community Work
